



# H5580F2RN Starburst Fountain

## STAGE 1

Prepare a suitable location for your new fountain. The fountain should sit on a firm and level pad.

## STAGE 2

Place Pump inside 6580H bowl unit. Insert pump Cord through the hole in the floor of the bowl. About 10" from pump, push Stopper around pump cord. Then push stopper into place in the bowl floor. Pull the cord out the bottom in preparation for connection once set up is completed.

## STAGE 3

Thread the smaller adapter into the top of the pump.

## STAGE 4

Slip the Restrictor onto the center of the tube. Tighten the Restrictor just enough to hold it in place on the tube.

## STAGE 5

Push an open end of the tube over the pump adapter's barb.

## STAGE 6

Thread the larger adapter into the bottom of the 5580H Starburst.

## STAGE 7

Place the 5580H Starburst top into position on top of the 6580H bowl unit. As you lower it into place, push the open end of the tube over the 5580H Starburst's barbed adapter.

## STAGE 8

Fill the bowl unit with water to about 1" from the top.

## STAGE 9


Read your pump instructions. Then, connect the pump and enjoy your fountain. If the pump does not immediately begin working, there may be an "airlock" within the impeller chamber. Simply turn the pump on and off a few times and it should remove the air lock and start.

## STAGE 10

If you desire to reduce the water flow, reach inside and tighten the Restrictor until the water flow matches your preference.

## STAGE 11

Shims have been provided with this fountain for your convenience. Once you run the fountain, shims can be used between the concrete pieces to adjust the level and help balance the water flow all around the fountain.



### IMPORTANT - WINTER CARE

Winter Ice build-up can cause damage to concrete statuary. Follow these tips to reduce winter weathering to your fountain:

- Disconnect power to pumps.
- Remove adapter from bottom bowl to open drains and let all moisture out. Keep drains open throughout winter.
- Place an absorbant material like burlap, blankets etc inside vases/bowls and cover all with a fountain cover.
- Do not allow snow or ice to build up on or against the concrete. Remove snow before it turns to ice. Do not use salt or chemical ice removers as these may damage concrete.
